

# **Winter Weather Policy During The The Winter Months:**

Please note that the inclement weather policy of CHBC coincides with the Kingsport City School schedule. If they start late, release early or close due to weather, the CHBC schedule follows suit. If a closing should occur on a Wednesday, the church's suppers and activities are also canceled.

### There Are Three Ways To Join Colonial Heights Baptist Church:

<u>Profession of Faith</u>: When a person accepts Christ as their personal Lord and Savior, becoming a new Christian, they may request membership by publicly professing their faith and asking for baptism. If a person has not been baptized by immersion, they may request membership through baptism.

<u>Transfer of Letter</u>: If a Christian is a member of another Baptist Church, they may request membership by asking that we accept them into our fellowship on promise of letter confirming their membership in a sister church. The church office contacts the sister church and requests the letter for transfer of membership.

Statement of Faith & Previous Baptism: If a person is a Christian but not a member of Baptist Church, they may request membership by giving testimony of having accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior and having been previously baptized as a believer by immersion.
